

5 Things About the Handicap System:

1. Fewer scores count toward your index. 8 of your past 20 scores are used. This allows for greater responsiveness to good scores and rewards more consistent play.
2. Your index is calculated daily (or at least any day after a golfer posts a new score)
3. The WHS has a maximum stroke total, using net double bogey as the universal standard.
4. **Playing Conditions Calculation (PCC)** adjusts how your score impacts your Index depending on the average of all scores posted at that course that day.
5. Your course handicaps reflect the strokes you get in relation to *par*, a more intuitive measure for most golfers.

We hope that all of you with Cellphones have discovered the **GHIN app**. This is the easiest way to post your golf scores following play! The app also has some great information about your Handicap!
